

Ludek Matyska, PhD, is an Associate Professor and currently a Dean of the Faculty of Informatics at Masaryk University Brno, Czech Republic. He is also a Senior Scientist at CESNET, Prague, Czech Republic. Originally educated in biochemistry, he did his PhD in chemical physics, leading to his current position as Associate Professor of Informatics. He has been with the Faculty of Informatics since 1994 and his scientific interests lie in the areas of parallel and distributed computing, high-performance networks and their applications, and also in mobile computing. All these activities fit well into the Grid framework. He is currently involved in two large EU projects: the DataGRID and GridLab, where he is chair of the Czech groups involved. Since 1996 he has also been affiliated with CESNET, the organisation that is responsible for NREN backbone in the Czech Republic. There he leads the Grid-related activities, most notably the MetaCenter project of the Czech Republic.
